"Sight Words"

All of the Sight Words used in the Word Family Reader Program are from the "Word Bank of 1200 High Frequency Core Words" in the Sitton Spelling and Word Skills Seminar Handbook.* These words are the 1200 most frequently used words in the English language.

From this list, the first 141 words are used. Of these 141 words, 101 are used as Sight Words and 40 as Family Words.

When students have completed all 68 books in the Word Family Reader Program, they will have covered the "high frequency core words" slightly into the third grade level. (The second grade level ends with word 130.)
